INTRODUCTION

The Eastern Cape is one of the previously disadvantaged provinces in South Africa. This is largely due to the poverty found in the former homelands, where subsistence agriculture predominates.

The real economy of the Eastern Cape is characterised by a relatively high share of manufacturing, but an economy that lags the national economy in productivity terms. This arose largely from the co-existence of:

- A strong manufacturing sector centered on the auto industry in the coastal metros, and
- The incorporation of two large apartheid “homeland” regions, which were historically heavily deprived of resources, infrastructure and public services.

In this context, the province has seen relatively slow employment growth and low pay, especially in the past four years. Since the transition to democracy, it has also experienced unusually high levels of migration out of the province.

The province is struggling because of poor education which lack of electricity; roads infrastructure water & sanitation amongst other things are a high contributing factor. After careful consideration of these issues Bazakhe Projects was then born to contribute to changing the status of our province, and pave a way for our young brothers and sisters.

Its main business is Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering (including Maintenance), recently extended our profile to General Building and Road Markings. Company has undertaken various projects in both fields (Electrical & Civil) and completed them in time, within budget. 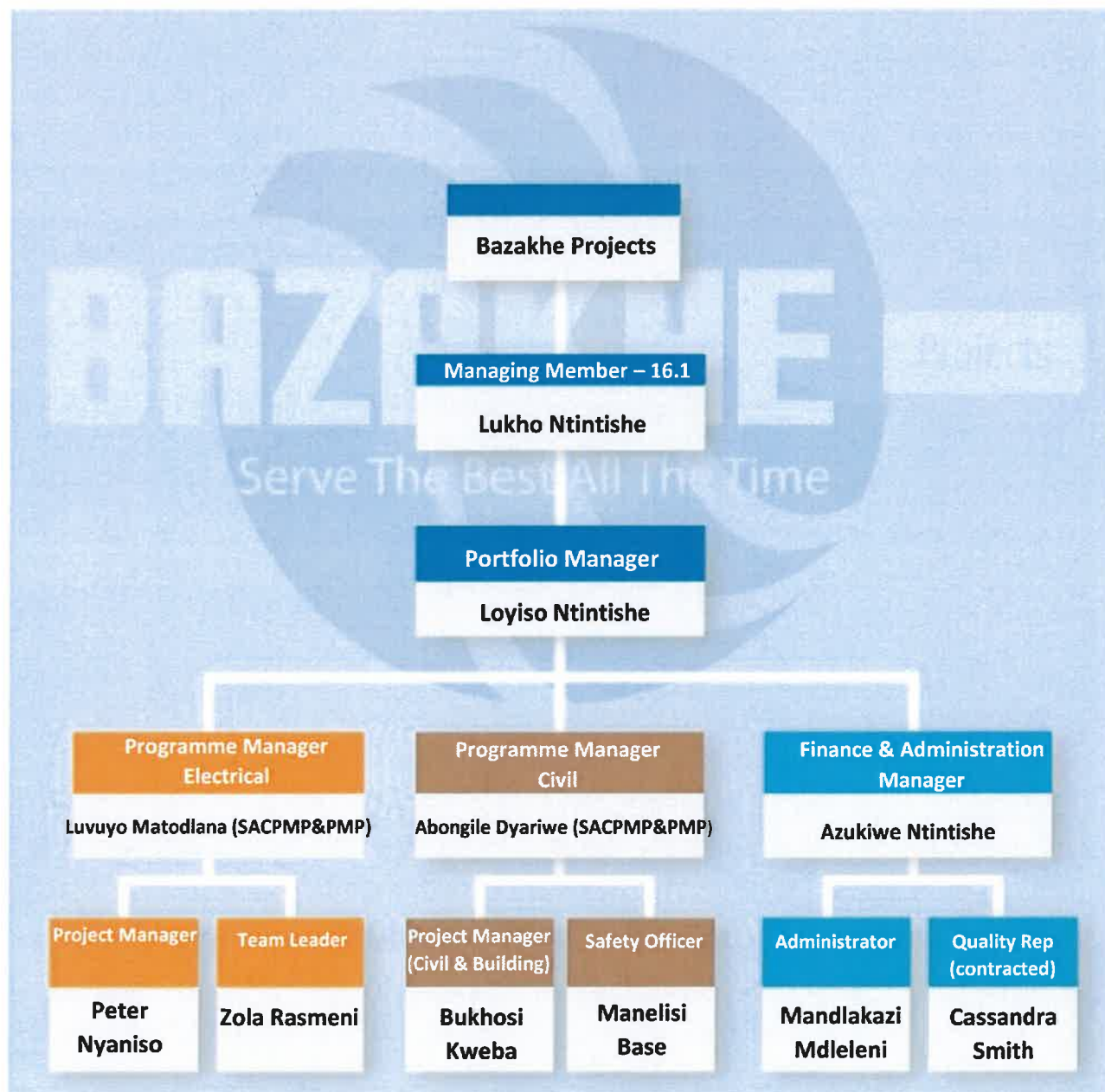

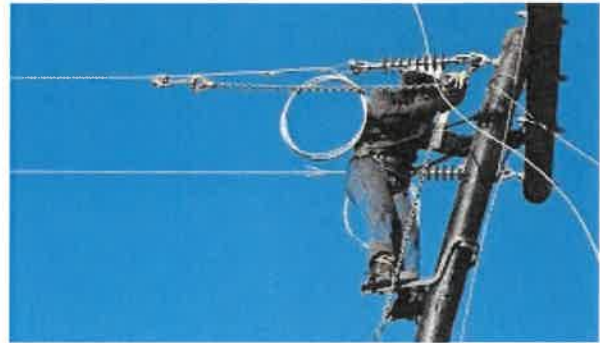
